BACKGROUND:

In an effort to further streamline the Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH) application process for Albertans, beginning May 25, 2020 all applications will be assessed in in the following order:

- General Eligibility
- Medical Eligibility
- Financial Eligibility

Applicants who do not meet general or medical eligibility requirements will be notified of the decision. Further,

- If an applicant is denied due to general eligibility, their application will not be assessed for medical
 or financial eligibility.
- If an applicant is denied due to medical eligibility, their application will not be assessed for financial eligibility.
