BACKGROUND:

In response to the September 2023 E. coli outbreak in several Calgary childcare facilities, the Government of Alberta is issuing compassionate payments to eligible affected families.

These payments to Albertans are not considered income by the Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH) program, as they are not reportable to the Canada Revenue Agency.

To ensure that clients' eligibility and benefits are not impacted by these payments, the Minister has exercised his authority, through a Ministerial Order, to exempt these payments as an asset, including any asset to the extent it was purchased with the payment.

INTENT:

To ensure AISH policy accurately reflects the treatment of these Government of Alberta payments.
