BACKGROUND:

The Child Support Services (CSS) program must meet court requirements related to financial disclosure when filing Child Support applications in court. Program staff are responsible for determining the applicant's annual gross income for the current year. This includes determining the total amount of social assistance that the applicant could be expected to receive in the current year.

Income Support and Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH) rates have increased January 1, 2019. Rates will be indexed each year in January to keep up with inflation. Examples pertaining to calculating annual gross income have been updated to reflect the new rates.
