BACKGROUND:

The Government of Alberta is committed to helping Albertans obtain the skills they need to participate in the labour market by providing financial assistance to eligible individuals.

Effective April 1, 2014, individuals attending Occupational Training programs 12 weeks or longer in duration will apply for funding through Student Aid Alberta as these programs are not eligible for Alberta Works funding. This change will affect individuals planning to attend training on a full-time or a part-time basis.

Alberta Works funding will continue to be available for Human Services approved Occupational Training programs less than 12 weeks.
