BACKGROUND:

The DRES policy was reviewed and a revised format used to provide clarity.

Highlights of the policy changes:

- 1) Alignment of the DRES policy with the DRES Regulations.
 - a. Individual Eligibility
 - i. deleted temporarily working out of the province
 - ii. added must be at least 16 years of age or older
- 2) Vehicle Modification: clarified the intent of a valid driver's license to mean a minimum of Class 5 and without the need for an accompanying driver.

To align policy with the DRES Regulations and use a new format to make the policy less cumbersome by splitting the policy into five sections.
