BACKGROUND:

As part of the Government of Alberta's work in reviewing the delivery of its employment and training programs, the ministries of Advanced Education, Human Services and Labour shifted responsibility for various existing programs. As part of the Mandate Alignment, Labour is the lead for the Aboriginal Training to Employment Program (effective April 1, 2016).

An initial technical review of the Aboriginal Training to Employment Program policy and the First Nations Training to Employment Program policy has been completed, with revisions to reflect the Mandate Alignment.

Highlights of the policy and technical changes:

- 1) Identification of Labour as the program lead.
- 2) Removal of agreement web link that is no longer relevant as it is directed to a Community and Social Services web page.
- 3) Contact information updated to reflect current Indigenous Partnership Coordinators.
- 4) Change the term Aboriginal to Indigenous except where the program name is listed.
- 5) Update to reflect the policy applies to grant holders and not contract holders since it is a grant program.

INTENT:

Revised information provides clarification for program participants, making the policy less cumbersome and easier to understand.
