Subject: Changes to Performance Measures – 180 Day Follow-Up

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BACKGROUND:

The <u>Performance Measures</u> (PM) policy was updated to reflect Alberta's responsibility for reporting requirements under the Federal labor market agreements with Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC).

The previous PM policy required 90 day and 180 day follow-ups. The revised policy requires a 90 day post intervention review (follow-up) occurs. Program areas may choose to conduct additional follow-ups to obtain more outcome data for their specific program needs, but only a 90 day follow-up is the minimum required to meet provincial obligation under the PM policy.

In addition, the Government of Alberta will use reports from the Work Outcome Reporting Project (WORP), a group of surveys that collect follow-up outcome data on the employment and training status of former participants of identified funded programs and services. Participants are contacted at 90 days and one year intervals. The surveys are conducted by a third party firm who reports the results to the Government of Alberta.
