**BACKGROUND:**

Advanced Education has created a new program called Integrated Foundational Pathways (IFP). Training programs approved under this program will provide adult Albertans with a unique blend of essential skills, academics and applied skills development to allow them to build on their foundational competences while preparing them for further education/training and employment.

Advanced Education will begin to accept IFP program approval applications starting September 2018. Further information will be communicated on the application process prior to this date.

**INTENT:**

Training programs approved under IFP will provide learning opportunities to Albertans who face barriers or who seek different pathways to attach to the labour market.
