

## Tax Information for Learners in Training Programs

The Government of Alberta is required to report on a tax slip all training benefits (tuition, fees, books and other costs) and income support (living allowance, child benefits, etc.) you have received from the Government of Alberta. Tax slips were mailed on February 23, 2021 for the 2020 taxation year.

Please allow 2 weeks from this date before inquiring about tax slips not received.

### **Information for Full-time Employment Insurance Learners and Learners attending training part-time:**

- You will receive a T4A tax slip.
- Income reported on the T4A tax slip is taxable.
- You may be able to offset the tuition reported in **Box 196 on the T4A** by claiming the Adult Basic Education Tuition Assistance Deduction.

### **Information for Full-time non-Employment Insurance Learners:**

- You will receive a T5007 tax slip.
  - Income reported on the T5007 tax slip is not taxable.
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### **NOTE:**

It is important to keep your mailing address up to date to ensure you receive the tax slips you need to complete your income tax return.

Copies of your tax slips are also sent to the CRA.
