## **BACKGROUND:**

A new <u>Foundational Learning Assistance Regulation</u> came into force on January 1, 2022 shifting the legal framework for Learner's financial assistance from the *Income and Employment Supports Act (IESA)* to the <u>Student Financial Assistance Act (SFAA)</u> for programs of study starting on or after April 1, 2022.

The Learner Income Support Program has been replaced by the new <u>Foundational Learning</u> <u>Assistance Program (FLAP)</u> for students with a training start date on or after April 1, 2022.
