A new [Foundational Learning Assistance Regulation](#) came into force on January 1, 2022 shifting the legal framework for Learner's financial assistance from the *Income and Employment Supports Act (IESA)* to the [Student Financial Assistance Act \(SFAA\)](#) for programs of study starting on or after April 1, 2022.

The Learner Income Support Program has been replaced by the new [Foundational Learning Assistance Program \(FLAP\)](#) for students with a training start date on or after April 1, 2022.
