BACKGROUND:

The EMP2470 Verification of Assistance (Letter) used under the Income Support (IS) program and DS2470 AISH Verification of Assistance (Letter) used under the Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH) program have been consolidated. The EMP2470 Verification of Assistance (Letter) will now be used under both the AISH and IS programs. The DS2470 AISH Verification of Assistance (Letter) has been removed from the <u>Government of Alberta Forms</u> <u>Repository</u>.

The **EMP2470 Verification of Assistance (Letter)** is completed at the request of the client and provided to the client directly. The letter is completed by the program to verify that a client is in receipt of assistance and to confirm the client's monthly benefit rate. Clients use this letter to provide evidence of their ongoing income source to a third party such as a landlord or childcare provider.

Completion of the **EMP2470 Verification of Assistance (Letter)** is the preferred method to verify a client is receiving assistance and protect the client's privacy. Although the Notice of Eligibility form and monthly benefit statement provide evidence that a client is receiving assistance, these documents may contain more personal information than is needed to share with a third party.
