## BACKGROUND:

An appeal package contains all documentation the department used to make the decision under appeal and must be made available to the client prior to the appeal hearing.

Policy has been updated to clarify the contents required in the appeal package and that the package must be made available to the client no less than seven calendar days prior to the appeal hearing date. The date the appeal package is mailed must be recorded in AIMS.

These changes are effective immediately and may impact appeals already in progress.

Note: References to business days have been changed to calendar days in some areas of policy.
