

MINISTERIAL ORDER No. 2016-16

WHEREAS the Government of Alberta may provide compensation for damage or loss caused by a disaster as determined by the Government of Alberta;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Schedule 1, section 2(1)(o) of the *Income Support, Training and Health Benefits Regulation* (the Regulation) under the *Income and Employment Supports Act*, the Minister may exempt an asset that was purchased with money exempted under section 1(1)(n), (x) or (y) of Schedule 2;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Schedule 2, section 1(1)(q) of the Regulation, the Minister may exempt cash gifts of a non-recurring nature from the determination of financial resources;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Schedule 2, section 1(1)(y) of the Regulation, the Minister may exempt any payment received from a Province of Canada;

I, CHRISTINA GRAY, Minister of Labour, hereby:

- 1 Pursuant to Schedule 1, section 2(1)(o) of the Regulation, exempt assets purchased with compensation made by the Government of Alberta for damage or loss caused by a disaster as determined by the Government of Alberta;
- 2 Pursuant to Schedule 2, section 1(1)(q) of the Regulation, exempt 100% of the payments issued by charitable organizations for a disaster determined by the Government of Alberta; and
- 3 Pursuant to Schedule 2, section 1(1)(y) of the Regulation, exempt 100% of compensation made by the Government of Alberta for damage or loss caused by a disaster as determined by the Government of Alberta.
