MESSAGE:

On November 27, 2018 Canada Post's rotating strikes ended and regular service resumed. The Ministries of Advanced Education and Labour have decided to issue the January 2019 Learner Income Support cheques via courier to training providers ensuring timely delivery.

Due to school closures, cheques for learners will be printed on December 10th for January payments.

Learners whose payments are activated after the following dates should be aware they will not receive their cheques until January 2019:

1. New learners activated after December 12th
2. Returning learners activated after December 14th

Learners who have opted for electronic funds transfer (EFT) will receive their benefits as normally scheduled around December 19th (dependant on the financial institution).

Normal processes for cheque distribution will resume January 2019.
