MESSAGE:

Advanced Education's new Foundational Learning Assistance Program (FLAP) will launch for programs of study with start dates on or after April 1, 2022.

As the winter semesters started prior to April 1, 2022, 16-19 year old high school students will continue to apply for Learner Income Support and follow the current application process for the remainder of the school year.

Beginning in the 22/23 academic year, high school students will apply for the Foundational Learning Assistance Program. A verified MyAlberta Digital ID will be required to access the simplified on-line application. As this may not always be feasible for 16-19 year old students, an alternative process will be available where required.

Detailed information on enrolment confirmation and application process for 16-19 year old high school students will be available prior to the fall application submissions.
