

Ministerial Order No. 2019-10

WHEREAS the Government of Canada may provide compensation to Canadian Armed Forces members and Veterans for pain and suffering due to a service-related injury or illness either in the form of a lump sum or in monthly payments;

AND WHEREAS this compensation was known as the Disability Award;

AND WHEREAS, effective April 1, 2019, the Government of Canada replaced the Disability Award with the Pain and Suffering Compensation payment;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1(1)(y) of Schedule 2 of the Income Support, Training and Health Benefits Regulation (the Regulation) under the *Income and Employment Supports Act*, the Minister may exempt a payment received from the Government of Canada from the determination of financial resources;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1(1)(n.2) of Schedule 1 of the Regulation, the Minister may exempt an asset or liquid asset that was purchased or obtained with money exempted under section 1(1)(y) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation for the purpose of determining assets;

I, RAJAN SAWHNEY, Minister of Community and Social Services:

- 1 Pursuant to section (1)(1)(y) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation, exempt a payment received from the Government of Canada for a Disability Award or for a Pain and Suffering Compensation payment from the determination of financial resources; and
- 2 Pursuant to section 1(1)(n.2) of Schedule 1 of the Regulation, exempt an asset or liquid asset that was purchased or obtained with money from a Disability Award or a Pain and Suffering Compensation payment for the purpose of determining assets.
