**Ministerial Order
No. 2020-005**

WHEREAS the Government of Canada has agreed to make lump-sum payments to class action members related to harm done as a result of policies and practices implemented under the *War Veterans Allowance Act* (Canada) and the *Veterans Well-Being Act* (Canada) under the Raymond Michael Toth v. Her Majesty the Queen Class Action Settlement Agreement;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1(1)(x) of Schedule 2 of the Income Support, Training and Health Benefits Regulation (the Regulation) under the *Income and Employment Supports Act*, the Minister may exempt a payment received from the Government of Canada to compensate for a harm done and received as a member of a class, from the determination of financial resources;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1(1)(n.2) of Schedule 1 of the Regulation, the Minister may exempt an asset or liquid asset that was purchased or obtained with money exempted under section 1(1)(x) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation for the purpose of determining assets;

I, RAJAN SAWHNEY, Minister of Community and Social Services:

- 1 Pursuant to section 1(1)(x) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation, exempt a payment received by class action members as a result of the Raymond Michael Toth v. Her Majesty the Queen Class Action Settlement Agreement with the Government of Canada from the determination of financial resources; and
- 2 Pursuant to section 1(1)(n.2) of Schedule 1 of the Regulation, exempt an asset or liquid asset that was purchased or obtained with money from a payment received by class action members as a result of the Raymond Michael Toth v. Her Majesty the Queen Class Action Settlement Agreement with the Government of Canada for the purpose of determining assets.
