

## Ministerial Order No. 2020-007

WHEREAS the Government of Canada and Sixties Scoop class action members have agreed to the Sixties Scoop Settlement Agreement;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1(1)(x) of Schedule 2 of the Income Support, Training and Health Benefits Regulation (the Regulation) under the *Income and Employment Supports Act*, the Minister may exempt a payment received from the Government of Canada to compensate for a harm done and received as a member of a class, from the determination of financial resources;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1(1)(n.2) of Schedule 1 of the Regulation, the Minister may exempt an asset or liquid asset that was purchased or obtained with money exempted under section 1(1)(x) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation for the purpose of determining assets;

- I, RAJAN SAWHNEY, Minister of Community and Social Services:
- 1 Pursuant to section (1)(1)(x) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation, exempt a payment received by class action members as a result of the Sixties Scoop Settlement Agreement with the Government of Canada from the determination of financial resources; and
- 2 Pursuant to section 1(1)(n.2) of Schedule 1 of the Regulation, exempt an asset or liquid asset that was purchased or obtained with money from a payment received by class action members as a result of the Sixties Scoop Settlement Agreement with the Government of Canada for the purpose of determining assets.
