**MINISTERIAL  
ORDER  
No. 2021-04**

WHEREAS certain provisions may be established by the Minister for the purposes of the Income Support, Training and Health Benefits Regulation (the Regulation) under the *Income and Employment Supports Act*;

AND WHEREAS the Government of Alberta may provide temporary financial aid to eligible individuals upon completion of self-isolation at a hotel due to COVID-19;

AND WHEREAS the COVID self-isolation payment may be provided to those individuals referred from Alberta Health Services (AHS) to isolate in an isolation hotel and remain in the hotel for the duration specified by AHS;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1(1)(y) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation, the Minister may exempt a payment received from the Government of Alberta from the determination of financial resources, to the extent determined by the Minister;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 2(1)(o.2) of Schedule 1 of the Regulation, the Minister may exempt an asset or liquid asset that was purchased or obtained with money exempted under section 1(1)(y) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation for the purpose of determining assets;


I, JASON COPPING, Minister of Labour and Immigration:

1. Pursuant to section 1(1)(y) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation, exempt the COVID self-isolation payment received from the Government of Alberta from the determination of financial resources; and
2. Pursuant to section 2(1)(o.2) of Schedule 1 of the Regulation, exempt an asset or liquid asset that was purchased or obtained with money from the COVID self-isolation payment received from the Government of Alberta for the purpose of determining assets.

This Order is effective January 1, 2021.
