

Ministerial Order No. 2021-006

WHEREAS the Government of Canada may provide temporary income support payments to eligible individuals who have lost employment or self-employment income because of COVID-19 and have not voluntarily quit their job or are eligible for Employment Insurance regular or sickness benefits;

AND WHEREAS the Canada Recovery Benefit, Canada Recovery Sickness Benefit and the Canada Recovery Caregiving Benefit (Canada Recovery Benefit payments) will provide eligible Albertans up to \$500 per week for a maximum of 26 weeks (the eligibility period) between September 27, 2020 and September 25, 2021;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1(l) of Table 1 of Schedule 1.1 of the Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped General Regulation (the Regulation) under the Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped Act, the Minister may exempt a payment received from the Government of Canada from the determination of income;

I, RAJAN SAWHNEY, Minister of Community and Social Services, pursuant to section 1(I) of Table 1 of Schedule 1.1 of the Regulation, exempt Canada Recovery Benefit payments received from the Government of Canada by an existing client or a cohabiting partner of an existing client for the period between September 27, 2020 and March 31, 2021 from the determination of income.
