

Ministerial Order No. 2021-016

WHEREAS the Government of Canada may issue a one-time lump sum payment to a recipient under the Memorial Grant Program for First Responders;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1(1)(y) of Schedule 2 of the Income Support, Training and Health Benefits Regulation (the Regulation) under the *Income and Employment Supports Act*, the Minister may exempt a payment received from the Government of Canada, to the extent determined by the Minister, from the determination of financial resources;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1(1)(n.2) of Schedule 1 of the Regulation, the Minister may exempt an asset or liquid asset that was purchased or obtained with money exempted under section 1(1)(y) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation for the purpose of determining assets;

I, RAJAN SAWHNEY, Minister of Community and Social Services:

- 1. Pursuant to section 1(1)(y) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation, exempt a payment received from the Government of Canada under the Memorial Grant Program by a member of a barriers to full employment or an expected to work or working household unit, from the determination of financial resources; and
- 2. Pursuant to section 1(1)(n.2) of Schedule 1 of the Regulation, exempt an asset or liquid asset that was purchased or obtained with money from a payment received from the Government of Canada under the Memorial Grant Program by a member of a barriers to full employment or an expected to work or working household unit, for the purpose of determining assets.
