

Ministerial Order No. 2021-030

WHEREAS the Government of Alberta may provide a \$100 Covid-19 vaccination incentive payment to Albertans 18 years or older who get their first or second Covid-19 vaccination dose;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1(1)(y) of Schedule 2 of the Income Support, Training and Health Benefits Regulation (the Regulation) under the *Income and Employment Supports Act*, the Minister may exempt a payment received from a Province of Canada, to the extent determined by the Minister, from a determination of financial resources;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1(1)(n.2) of Schedule 1 of the Regulation, the Minister may exempt an asset or liquid asset that was purchased or obtained with money exempted under section 1(1)(y) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation, for the purpose of determining assets for a barriers to full employment household unit or an expected to work or working household unit;

I, JASON LUAN, Minister of Community and Social Services:

- 1. Pursuant to section 1(1)(y) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation, exempt a Covid-19 vaccination incentive payment received from the Government of Alberta from a determination of financial resources for a barriers to full employment household unit or an expected to work or working household unit; and
- 2. Pursuant to section 1(1)(n.2) of Schedule 1 of the Regulation, exempt an asset or liquid asset that was purchased or obtained with a Covid-19 vaccination incentive payment received from the Government of Alberta, for the purpose of determining assets for a barriers to full employment household unit or an expected to work or working household unit.
