

## Ministerial Order No. 2023-028

## SENIORS, COMMUNITY AND SOCIAL SERVICES Office of the Minister

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 7(1) of Schedule 1 of the *Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped Act*, the Minister may determine the amount of a personal benefit and the frequency with which a personal benefit may be provided;

AND WHEREAS section 12 of Schedule 3 of the Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped General Regulation outlines circumstances when a funeral benefit may be paid.

- I, Jason Nixon, Minister of Seniors, Community and Social Services, pursuant to section 7(1) of Schedule 1 of the Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped Act, hereby:
  - 1. Establish the amounts of funeral benefits under section 12 of Schedule 3 of the Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped General Regulation, as follows:
    - a. Section 12(a):
      - i. funeral expenses for burial or cremation, the actual cost up to \$4,421;
      - ii. a funeral ceremony, the actual cost up to \$1,000;
      - iii. embalming, when deemed necessary by an embalmer licensed under section 20 of the General Regulation of the *Funeral Services Act*, the actual cost up to \$750;
      - iv. as outlined in the additional kilometre portion of section 3(1) of the Schedule of the Fatality Inquiries Regulation, a rate of up to \$1.13 a kilometre after 20 kilometres, for transportation and attendant services. This rate is provided per trip when transportation is required outside the municipality where the funeral service provider is located; and
      - v. the actual reasonable cost of a single cemetery plot or other resting place, perpetual fees, grave opening and closing fees plus winter fees, if applicable, and a grave liner.
        - 1. In accordance with section 12 of the Cemeteries Act, cemetery plots are paid at 50% of the amount that would ordinarily be charged.
    - b. Section 12(b), the actual reasonable cost to prepare the remains for transport and to transport the remains.

2. Rescind Ministerial Order No. 2022-002 of the former Department of Community and Social Services.

This Ministerial Order comes into effect on January 1, 2024.
