Program Element	Program Code	Description
Literacy & Numeracy Grades 1-3	700	Literacy skills (reading, writing, speaking, spelling, math) Grades 1 – 3 level.
Literacy & Numeracy Grades 4-6	701	Literacy skills (reading, writing, speaking, spelling, math) Grades 4 – 6 level.
Adult Basic Education Grades 7-9	702	Basic Academic skills (reading, writing and math) Grades 7 – 9 level.
Academic Upgrading Grades 10 - 12	703	Grades 10 -12 equivalency or high school credit courses.
English as a Second Language (ESL)	704	English language skills development training.
Life Skills/Personal Management	705	Personal development which may include analysis of values, goals, aptitudes and strengths.
Pre-technology Preparation	707	Academic subjects needed to meet entrance requirements at Technical Institutes.
University and College Entrance Preparation	708	Academic subjects needed to meet entrance requirements at Colleges and Universities.
Integrated Foundational Pathways	739	A unique blend of essential skills, academics and applied skills development designed to build upon foundational competencies.

Program Element	Program Code	Description
Alberta Job Corps	801	Provides work-place experience and training for individuals who have demonstrated they are unable to obtain or maintain employment.
Alberta Settlement and Integration Program (ASIP)	9150	Projects that support immigrants in overcoming barriers to workplace integration
Immigrant Bridging	741	Integrated skills training programs, that help immigrants with prior experience or education bridge gaps in knowledge, and/or skills.
Immigrant Bridging (contract-based)	742	Contract-based immigrant bridging programs trains skilled immigrants with prior education and/or experience in specific occupations bridge gaps in knowledge or skills to gain employment.
Integrated Training	740	Training programs that combine academic and general employability skills with job-specific skills.
Integrated Training (contract-based)	761	Contract-based training programs with a unique blend of occupation related skills, work experience placements, employability skills and applied academics and/or English as a Second Language.

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Occupational Skills	See Appendix	Training programs offered in occupational areas of average and/or above average demand.
Self Employment	764	Provides training that facilitates entry into self-employment by offering individuals formal instruction on business plan development, business counselling, coaching and guidance.
Transitional Vocational Program	737	A program that combines training and work experience to assist individuals with a developmental disability to obtain and maintain employment and gain independence.
Workforce Adjustment Activity	807	Assists former employees, impacted by workforce adjustment, with training costs. Training will lead to a credential offered at a publicly funded post-secondary institution or First Nations College.
Workplace Training	910	Supports employer-driver work-site training and paid-work experience opportunities to those who are unemployed and experiencing barriers to employment.

Disability Related Employment Supports (DRES) - Educational	802	Financial assistance program for educational supports to overcome barriers created by disabilities.
Disability Related Employment Supports (DRES) - Job Search	803	Financial assistance program for job search supports to overcome barriers created by disabilities.
Disability Related Employment Supports (DRES) - Workplace	804	Financial assistance program for workplace supports to overcome barriers created by disabilities.
Exposure Course	903	Short courses required by job-ready individuals to obtain employment.
Follow-up	911	Contact with successful completers three months after conclusion of their service plan to determine the outcome and provide support.
Job Placement	905	Designed to support individuals through the development of job search skills for effective labour market transitions.
Record Result	9110	Outcome results for participants of contract or grant funded programming.
Transition to Employment Services	9140	Provides services that facilitate rapid attachment to the labour market. Services include job matching, short-term courses and equipment required for the job.
Workshop	909	A group service designed to address a variety of career and employment needs.
