

ORDER No. 2016-11

I, Jeff Parr, Deputy Minister of Labour, in accordance with Section 45(1) of the Income Support, Training and Health Benefits Regulation under the *Income and Employment Supports Act*, determine the acceptable attendance requirements for EI and Non-EI Full-time Learners, as set out in the attached Appendix, to maintain income support and benefits and training benefits while attending full-time training programs approved by Labour.

This Order is effective April 1, 2016.

APPENDIX

EI and Non-EI Full-time Learners

Section 45(1) – For the purpose of determining whether a learner member has met the acceptable attendance for EI and Non-EI Full-time Learners to maintain income support and benefits and training benefits while attending full-time training programs approved by Advanced Education, the following requirements shall be applied under this section:

- (a) the learner must attend training regularly;
- (b) the learner member must report both excused and unexcused absences to training providers and provide supporting documents in accordance with the requirements of the training providers;
- (c) a learner member who exceeds the training provider's policy on unexcused absences is considered automatically withdrawn from the approved full-time training program;
- (d) a learner member who is absent for more than three consecutive weeks, excused and/or unexcused, will be considered automatically withdrawn from their training program, unless authorized by the Director;
- (e) a learner member who completes their approved training program earlier than the scheduled completion date will be considered withdrawn from their approved training program.
