


INFORMATION FOR ACADEMIC UPGRADING APPLICANTS

WHO SHOULD USE THIS FORM? If this is your first time being funded by *Advancing Futures to* take high school (upgrading) courses, or if you did not attend upgrading at the same institution last academic year, please complete this form to request funding for your schooling. If you are unsure which application to complete, please call *Advancing Futures* at (780) 415-0085 (toll-free, dial 310-0000 first).

ABOUT YOUR APPLICATION

Advancing Futures applications take 6-8 weeks to process. All sections of the application form MUST be completed before it can be reviewed. Incomplete applications will be returned and not processed.

The personal information collected on this form will be used to review your eligibility for the *Advancing Futures* bursary and the Alberta Adult Health Benefit program.

Please note that according to Canada Revenue Agency Upgrading is not considered Post-Secondary and may not be a tax deduction. You may not be eligible for a T2202A from your institution and as a result you may be responsible to pay additional taxes to Canada Revenue Agency . THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

♦ Health Care Coverage

Students approved to receive an *Advancing Futures* bursary may be enrolled in the Alberta Adult Health Benefit Program if they meet the program's criteria. (Students who have health coverage through Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH) or who have Registered Status under the Indian Act already receive health coverage and do not qualify for the *Advancing Futures* health benefit.) The Alberta Adult Health Benefit program pays for health services that are not available through standard Alberta Health Care insurance, such as eyeglasses, prescription drugs, and dental care. Staying In Touch

If your personal information (address, bank account direct deposit information, phone number or e-mail, etc.) changes, you must contact the *Advancing Futures* bursary program IMMEDIATELY! Failure to notify the program of changes may affect your funding.

Recipients may be provided a maximum fixed monthly living allowance based on double occupancy.

It can be unlawful to receive multiple sources of funding. If you are awarded an *Advancing Futures* bursary, it is recommended that you inform any others from whom you are receiving financial assistance.

I'VE SUBMITTED MY APPLICATION. NOW WHAT? =

Completing your application is the first step of the process for receiving funding. Once your application has been reviewed for completeness and it has been determined that you are eligible to receive funding (this may take as long as 6-8 weeks), you will be notified of your next steps by your program coordinator.

Students who meet the program requirements will be CONDITIONALLY APPROVED for funding. At this point, you will receive a letter explaining any further steps that need to be completed. ALL STUDENTS who are conditionally approved will be required to complete the *Advancing Futures* Online Orientation and the Resiliency Survey before they can receive final approval for funding. A letter explaining how to do this will be mailed to you once you are conditionally approved.

When you have completed all of the requirements outlined in your Conditional Approval letter, *Advancing Futures* will provide final approval of your application for funding.

- 4. Is there any other education or training you hope to pursue in the future beyond the program that you identified above that relates to your education and career plan? If yes, explain. (1 mark)
- 5. What occupation or career are you hoping to pursue as a result of this education? (1 mark)
- 6. What is the salary range for jobs in this field? (1 mark)

WHY

- 1. Why is this career field of interest to you? (3 marks)
- 2. What personal characteristics and strengths do you have that makes this career a good fit for you? Explain how each characteristic or strength will contribute to your success in this career. (3 marks)
- 3. What are the challenges and disadvantages that you may encounter when employed in this field? (3 marks)

HOW

- 1. Who are your supports and how do they support you? (2 marks)
- 2. How will you manage the financial strain that may come along with being a student? (2 marks)
- 3. What personal challenges do you anticipate facing as a student and what are some of the things you can do to overcome them? (3 marks)
- 4. Thinking about your responses to the previous questions, what are you going to do to help yourself be successful? (2 marks)
- 5. What are your top three goals for this year and why are they important to you? Explain what supports you anticipate you will need, if any, to achieve your goals. (3 marks)

WHERE

- 1. Advancing Futures only funds upgrading of courses that are required for admission to your post-secondary program, therefore you will need to provide proof of program entrance requirements in order to be approved for funding for upgrading. Please attach a copy of the requirements/prerequisites for your program. (1 mark)
- 2. Attach a course plan from an advisor at the school you plan to attend to complete your upgrading. This should detail what courses are required for the university, college or trade program you plan to enroll in after completing upgrading, and during what terms (or quarters depending on your school) you will take these courses. If you do not have this program plan, you must include an explanation as to why and provide the date/time of your appointment with the school to get this program plan. (5 marks)
- 3. Why did you choose the school you are applying for funding to attend? (1 mark)
- 4. What other two institutions offer your program? (2 marks)

WHO

Although you will not be graded on these responses, the questions help your program coordinator to get to know you better.

- 1. Throughout the time you are funded by Advancing Futures, you will work with a Program Coordinator. Your Program Coordinator's role is to ensure your funding is in place and that you have the support you require to be successful with your educational goals. Is there anything you would like your Program Coordinator to know about you?
- 2. If everything were perfect, what would be happening in your life five years from now?

IMPORTANT REMINDERS =

Applications to attend a <u>post-secondary school</u> at any time during the upcoming academic year must be received on or before June 1, October 1 or February 1. Avoid disappointment: please re-check the information page and confirm the correct deadline for the type of school you wish to attend.

All sections of the application form must be completed before it can be reviewed. Applications received AFTER the application deadline will **NOT** be eligible for funding. Incomplete applications will be returned and not processed. The personal information collected on this form will be used to review your eligibility for the *Advancing Futures* bursary and the Alberta Adult Health Benefit program.

I'VE SUBMITTED MY APPLICATION. NOW WHAT? =

Provided that you have submitted a complete application (with all of the items on the checklist included) these are the next steps:

- 1. Your application will be reviewed and graded by your Program Coordinator.
- 2. Based on your results of that review you will either be conditionally approved or contacted directly by your Program Coordinator to address missing or incomplete items.
- 3. You will receive a conditional approval letter in the mail that outlines what you must do to have your application approved.
- 4. Once you have completed all of the required tasks outlined in your conditional approval letter and notified your Program Coordinator, your award will be approved.
- 5. You will receive an award approval letter in the mail confirming the details of your funding. Your school will also be notified of your sponsorship.
