- Requirement to provide a photocopy of identification when requesting a name change (along with a Change of Personal Information Form).


Please remind staff not to send criminal record checks with their application for certification, as they are no longer required for certification purposes as of November 1, 2008. Under the Child Care Licensing Regulation, criminal record checks are still required by the licence holder on each adult care provider and will be monitored by Child and Family Services Authority licensing staff.
