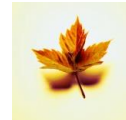

-  According to the latest census data (2006), Aboriginal children make up approximately **9%** of the child population in Alberta. In December 2013, they accounted for **69%** of the children In Care.

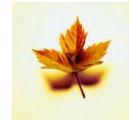

-  In December 2013, the most common placement types for children in care are Foster and Kinship Care:
 - ❖ **54% of children in care and placed in Foster Care; and**
 - ❖ **23% of children in care are placed in Kinship Care.**
-  There has been a **13% decrease** in permanency placements from Q3 2012/13.
-  There has been a **15% decrease** in group care from Q3 2012/13.
