 According to the latest census data (2006), Aboriginal children make up approximately **9%** of the child population in Alberta. In June 2014, they accounted for **69%** of the children in care.

 In June 2014, the most common placement types for children in care are Foster and Kinship Care:

- ❖ **54% of children in care are placed in Foster Care; and**
- ❖ **23% of children in care are placed in Kinship Care.**

 There has been a **30% decrease** in Independent Living placements from Q1 2013/14.


 There has been a **22% decrease** in the number of children placed in Group Care from Q1 2013/14.

Since the Protection of Children Involved in Prostitution Act (PCHIP) was introduced in February 1999, a total of 1,204 children and youth have been served within the PCHIP/PSECA Program. PCHIP was amended to PSECA in 2007.

 In 2013/14, **129 distinct children** were served through the *Protection of Sexually Exploited Children Act (PSECA)*. There has been an **decrease of 8%** since 2012/13.

Since DECA was introduced in November 2006, a total of 215 children and youth have been apprehended.

 In 2013/14, **20 distinct children** were apprehended under the *Drug Endangered Children Act (DECA)*. There has been a **decrease of 44%** since 2012/13.
