

Workplace Training – Participant Information

Workplace Training is a custom-made program supporting the training needs of eligible individuals and uses worksite-based training opportunities to teach specific skills for in-demand occupations.

Eligibility

To be eligible, a participant must be:

- Legally entitled to work in Canada
- Having difficulty finding and keeping employment
- 18 year of age or over

Participant must

- Need skills training
- Adhere to the employer's attendance policy

Training Duration

- Four to 30 weeks of full-time training (minimum of 30 hours/week)
- Part-time hours are available for persons with disabilities

What's expected?

- Agreement to a training plan developed with the employer and Workplace Training provider
- Agree to complete training
- Completion of a monthly progress report
- Continued employment after training is completed
